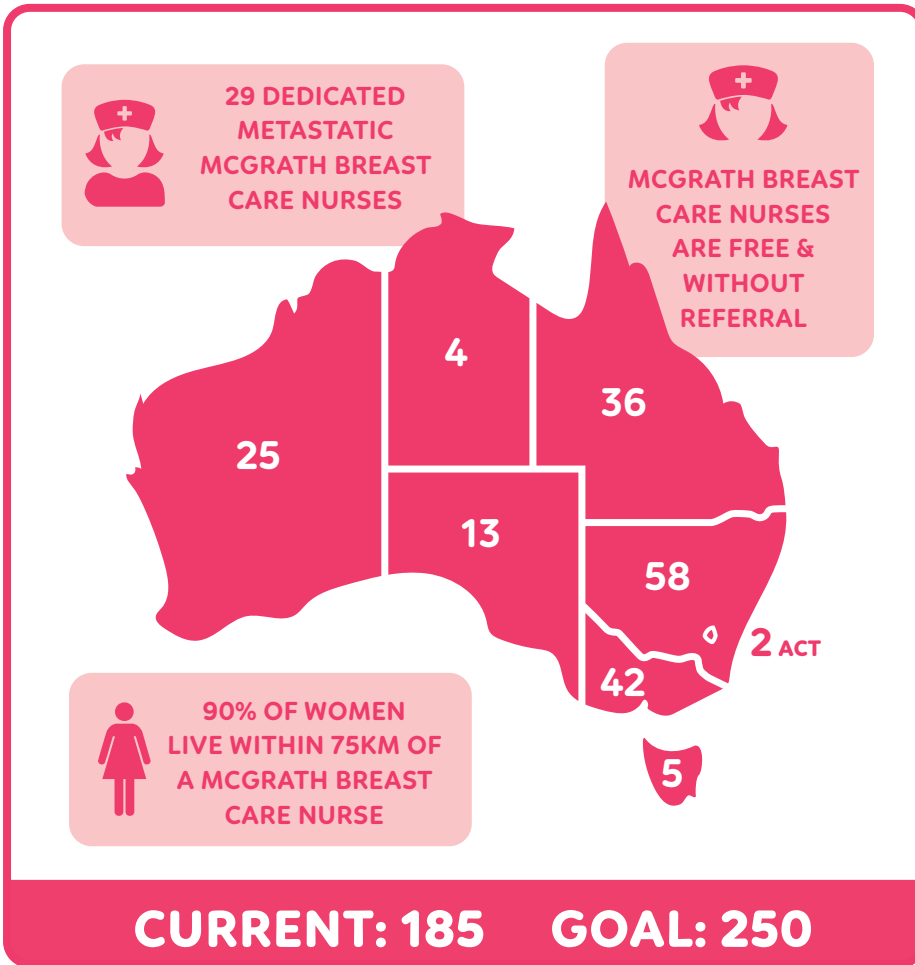
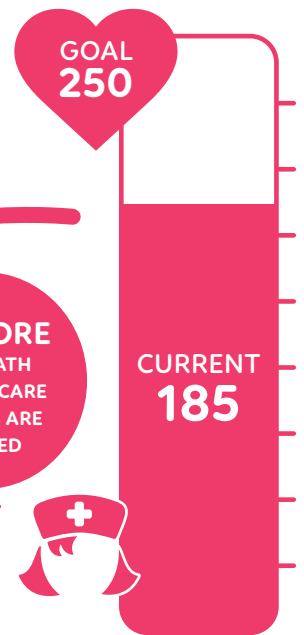


# 250 Nurses by 2025
